The society maven and Army and Navy Department Store CEO entertained the nipped-and-tucked at her 19th annual Face the World Foundation fete with special guest Goldie Hawn. More than 250 supporters dropped \$1,500—the most expensive gala ticket of any fundraiser on the social calendar—to party at the posh Point Grey home. The waterfront wingding attracted the city's who's who including business and community leaders, society heavyweights, philanthropists, politicians, sports stars and media personalities. Guests were greeted by Mac Viva Glam Go-Go Girls followed quickly by premium bubbles and an extraordinary repast catered by David Aisenstat's Shore Club. No ordinary raffle either.
